## **NEXT ELECTIONS:**

The following board members are on their second term and would like to be in the running to be re-elected for another term, George, Mark V., Erik, Art and Andrea. If reelected, George would like to continue as president, Art as Vice President, and Mark as Treasurer (with Andrea working with him to run as the next treasurer.)

PROCESS:

- Interested candidates write statements which are consolidated into one
  document to send out with the ballot and electronically via member newsletter.
- A letter from the president is sent out by mail, along with the ballots, candidate
  statements and return envelope at the beginning of June.
  - o By next election this process will be electronic after amending by-laws
- The official transition is July 1, so the ballots should be due at least by the Friday prior.

## **GRANT:**

- Around \$89K will be refunded
- Since this is the final invoice, Lydia won't submit it until after she receives the final progress report (due May 30th). We will likely see a check early July
- We do have a remaining 10K with McCue. Lauren to have meeting Tuesday to review.
- o Mark V. to make intro to ZAP grant writer for possible future grants.

## **NEW HIRE:**

- o Amanda Brower will be starting on May 15
- Need to set up Qualified Small Employer Health Reimbursement Arrangement.
  What does the \$500 payout look like- follow up with George on the consultant they work with.
- Amanda will be attending all board meetings.

## **PASSPORT:**

- Final Net sales \$569,457/ 2457 attendees
  - Goal was \$575,000 (under budget by \$5,543)
  - Reimbursement will be \$140,000 we had based it on 32 wineries \$128,000
    - So actually off budget by \$17,543
  - Waiting another week for full survey feedback from wineries AND attendees to report out and decide next steps for this event
